## Investment Strategy

An actively managed diversified portfolio of securities across both growth asset classes such as Australian equities, property and global securities, and defensive asset classes such as cash and fixed interest securities. In general, the portfolio's long-term average exposure will be around 80% growth assets and around 20% defensive assets; however the allocations will be actively managed within the allowable ranges depending on market conditions.

## Investment Objective

To achieve capital growth through investing in a diversified portfolio of growth and defensive asset classes, with a greater emphasis on growth asset classes.

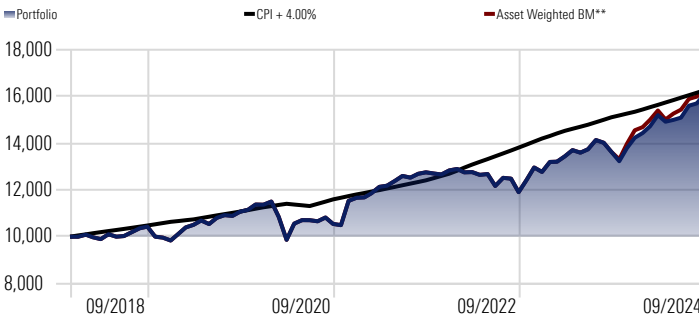
**Performance Objective:** To deliver outperformance of the asset weighted benchmark and additionally to aim to earn a rate of return that exceeds inflation by at least 4% per annum both over rolling 8-year periods.

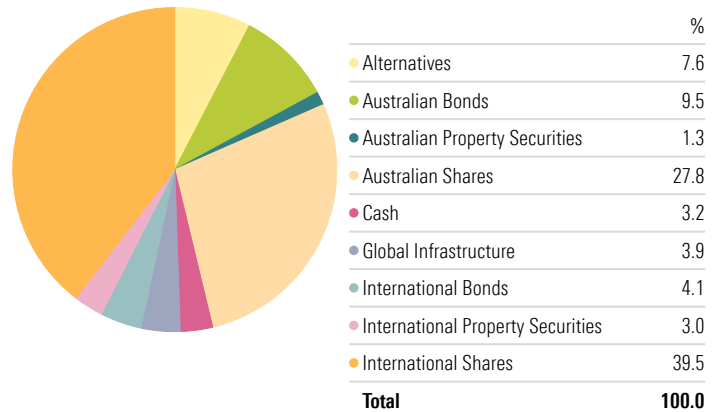

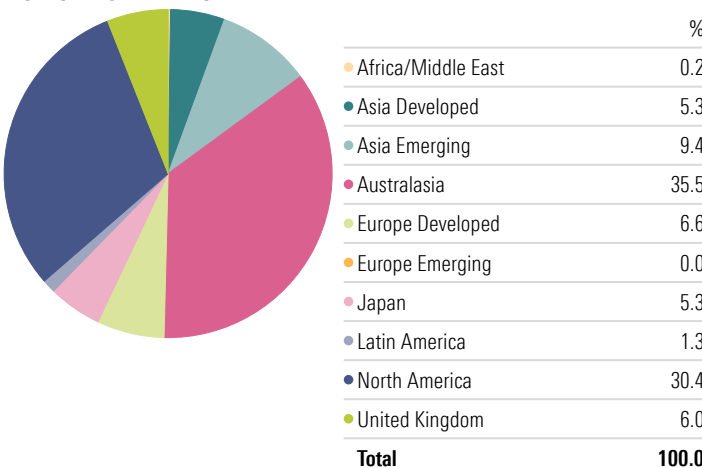

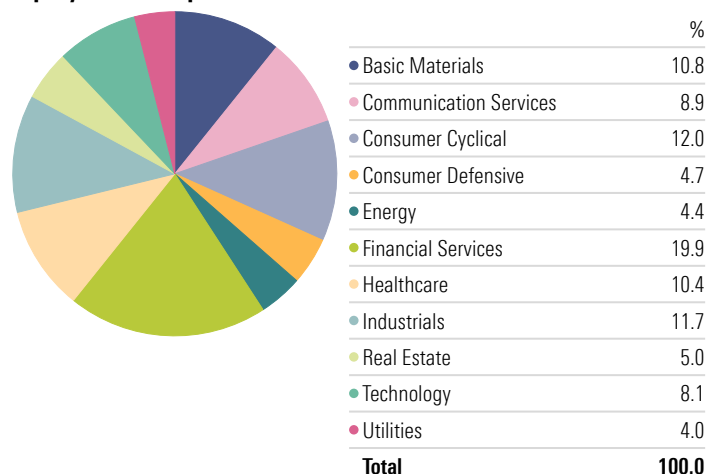
## Asset Allocation

## Equity Sector Exposure

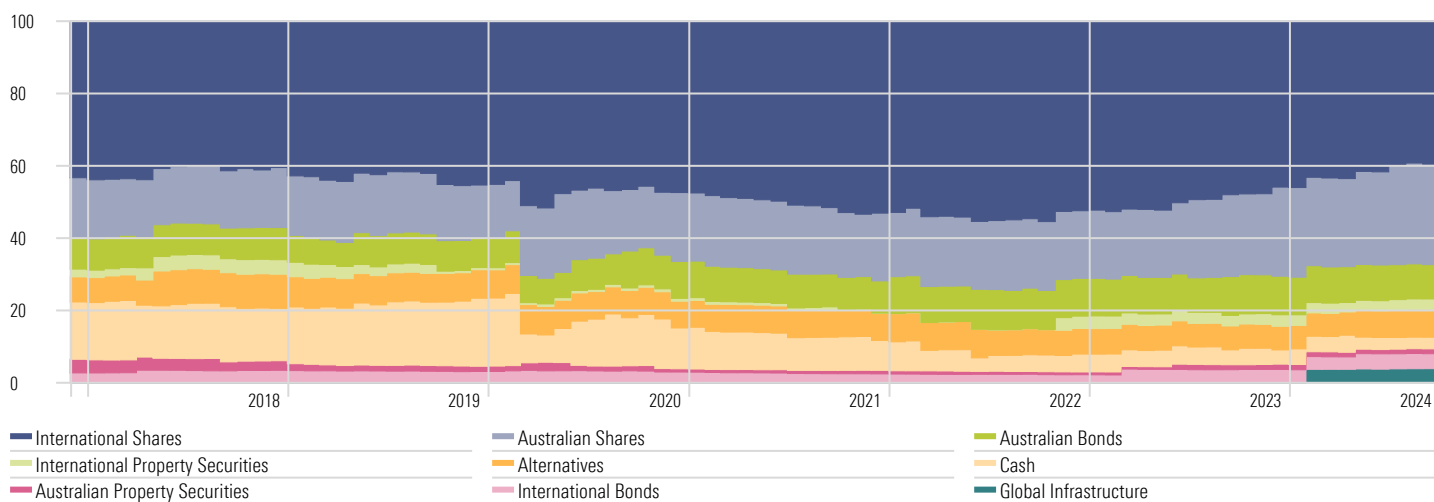
